Opportunities

- invited to social functions
- access to some of the communal produce, for example figs, fruit and herbs
- if also on the Waiting List, may have access to a raised planter. (2023)
- opportunity to hold a small private event in the garden, subject to conditions outlined below.

Contributions

- supporter of the aims of Alternative 3
- Invited to Volunteers on Thursday mornings
- invited to assist at Working Bees
- Invited to assist at Open Day
- Invited to assist with Hen Roster
- Invited to assist in certain Monitor roles
- Invited to provide specialist knowledge and skills.

Conditions

- may not have a key, unless appropriate and at the discretion of the Chairperson or their delegate, for example, watering planters or plots for plot-holders during the summer holidays.
- may not be elected to the Management Committee (MC)
- may attend MC meetings for a specific purpose by either invitation or application to the Chairperson or their delegate.
Persons with special interests or knowledge relevant to the Association may be invited to attend any meeting and to speak at the discretion of the chairperson but such a person may not vote (Constitution 6.2)
- must leave a MC meeting if an *in-camera* discussion and/or vote is to take place.
- may attend the AGM, but may not vote.
- any event that a FOTG wants to host must have the permission of the Chairperson or their delegate and the event must be sponsored by a plot holder who will take responsibility for the event. Please see *Guidelines for Holding Events #6.2*
